

How to Set Up a Mobile Hotspot

During this time, smartphone carriers are supporting families by turning your smartphone into a hotspot. Call your phone carrier if you are unsure if your plan supports a mobile hotspot.

How to Create a Mobile Hotspot on an Android Phone

Make sure your Data is turned on by going to Settings, then Data Usage.

Next, turn on your mobile hotspot from Settings:

1. Click [More Networks](#)
2. Click [Mobile Hotspot](#)
3. Slide the Off/On button to **On** (green)

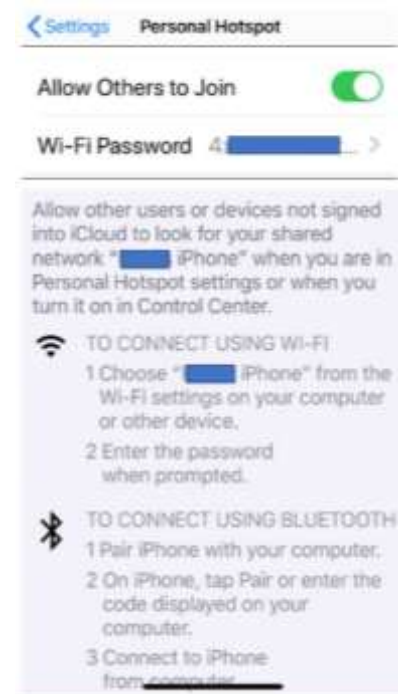


How to Create a Mobile Hotspot on an iPhone

Make sure your Data is turned on by going to Settings, then Cellular.

Next, turn on your mobile hotspot from Settings:

1. Click [Cellular](#)
2. Click [Personal Hotspot](#)
3. Allow Others to Join by switching the Off/On button to **On** (green)
4. Connect your other device using [Wi-Fi](#) or
5. Connect your other device using [Bluetooth](#)
