Want to join the PPMD team and help support parents and families? You have the opportunity to join PPMD as an AmeriCorps member to help organize volunteers so we can empower more families of children with disabilities and special healthcare needs.

This opportunity is an 11-month commitment as a member of AmeriCorps (the "domestic Peace Corps"). The service year offers extensive training, a \$16,502 pending funding living allowance, and a \$6,495 post-service education award. This program is a partnership between The Parents' Place of Maryland and Volunteer Maryland, a program of the Governor's Office.

Experience with disability and special healthcare need advocacy is preferred. Must be 17 years or older to apply.
